The city of Edinburgh: Scotland is one of the constituent countries of the United Kingdom. It occupies the northern third of the island of Great Britain and shares a land border to the south with England. Edinburgh, the nation's capital and second largest city, is increasingly being seen as a cosmopolitan alternative to Scotland's countryside, with visitors year round, though the main tourist season is generally from April to October. It is widely regarded as one of the most beautiful cities in Europe. It is the largest tourist destination in Scotland, attracting roughly 13 million visitors a year, and the second largest in the United Kingdom after London. It is also the city of the international festival. It presents a rich programme of classical music, theatre, opera and dance in six major theatres and concert halls and a number of smaller venues, over a three-week period in late summer each year.
