- Personal subject pronouns go before the verb:
- * I am at home.
- * You like music.
- * He wants to buy a new car.
- However, we place the auxiliary verb before subject pronouns in questions:
- * Can you help me?
- * Has she got the book?
- * Does he write very often?
- Personal object pronouns come after verbs and prepositions:
- * She loves me.
- * We send you an e-mail every day.

- * We go with him.
- A possessive adjective is followed by a noun and a possessive pronoun replaces it.
- * This is my van. It is mine.
- * Your lorry is very big, but theirs is the biggest one.
- * His house is enormous, but ours is very small.
