

Personal subject pronouns and possessive pronouns

Now study these rules:

Subject pronouns:	Object pronouns:	Possessive adjectives:	Possessive pronouns:
I you he she it we you they	me you him her it us you them	my your his her its our your their	mine yours his hers its ours yours theirs



■ Personal subject pronouns go before the verb:

- * I am at home.
- * You like music.
- * He wants to buy a new car.

■ However, we place the auxiliary verb before subject pronouns in questions:

- * Can you help me?
- * Has she got the book?
- * Does he write very often?

■ Personal object pronouns come after verbs and prepositions:

- * She loves me.
- * We send you an e-mail every day.

* We go with **him**.

■ A possessive adjective is followed by a noun and a possessive pronoun replaces it.

* This is **my** van. It is **mine**.

* **Your** lorry is very big, but **theirs** is the biggest one.

* **His** house is enormous, but **ours** is very small.
