How Chocolate Is Made

Chocolate comes from the cocoa tree.

First, workers pick the fruit. They take out the seeds. The seeds are cocoa beans.

The cocoa beans dry in the sun. Then they are sent to a factory.

The beans heat in an oven. Then they are mashed.

This makes a thick juice.
