

- Mr. Richards, 52, was checking the fences around his farm near Melbourne after severe storms. While he was walking around looking at the damage, a large branch from a nearby tree fell on his head.
- Lulu stood next to Dad's unconscious body and barked like a dog to get help," said the farmer's daughter, 17- year-old Celeste Richards. "She made this weird noise for about 15 minutes, so we went outside to see what the problem was," she added. "She was trying to get our attention. When we

got there, we saw Lulu standing over Dad's body. Without her, my Dad might be dead."
